

Janusz Reiter New Polish Ambassador to the U.S.



Janusz Reiter, a diplomat and a political commentator, the President of the Center for International Relations in Warsaw, has arrived in Washington, D.C., as the newly appointed Polish Ambassador.

A graduate of the University of Warsaw (German Department), Janusz Reiter served as editor of the daily Zycie Warszawy from 1977 till the paper was suppressed by martial law. He was among the founders and

editors of a number of opposition magazines; co-founder of the Foundation for International Initiatives and the Independent Center for International Studies; from 1984 to 1989, commentator of Przegląd Katolicki; and from 1990 to 1995, he served as Polish Ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany. Since 1998, he has been President of the Center for International Relations in Warsaw. Janusz Reiter was also a columnist for Rzeczpospolita and Co-chairman of the Polish-German Forum. He was a founding member of the Foreign Policy Council; member of the Academic Advisory Board and the Institute for Advanced Study Berlin. He was awarded the German Great Cross of Merit with the Star and Ribbon.
