Poland's Oscar-winning film director, Andrzej Wajda, was honored by the Berlin Film Festival for his life's work and for his films "Ashes and Diamonds" and "Man of Iron" made during the Solidarity uprisings in 1980.



He was also acclaimed for his participation in the Berlin Wall collapse.

Wajda is planning his next movie on the Katyn Forest Massacre, which is about the brutal massacre of some 22,000 Polish officers, officials and intellectuals, the cream of society, who were murdered by the Russians in 1940.
