 the 86th Pulaski Day Parade  
 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

On Sunday, October 6, 2019, the 86th Annual Pulaski Day Parade will step off at 12 Noon on the Benjamin Franklin Parkway in Center City, Philadelphia. It will be televised beginning at 12:30 PM on WPVI TV 6 ABC.

This year the Pulaski Day Parade will highlight "Firsts in Polish History", and the 400th Anniversary of the First Strike in America by the Polish settlers at Jamestown, Virginia, in 1619. The Polish craftsmen caused the first civil rights action in America in the form of a work stoppage demanding their participation in the legislative body in the new American colony. This year's parade will also highlight the 80th anniversary of the invasion of Poland on September 1, 1939, by Hitler's Nazi forces. The Polish Army has been renowned in Polish and world history as the First to Fight against Nazi Germany invaders.
